

Osteopathic Council (Fees) Notice 2023

Pursuant to Part 6, sections 130(1) and 131(1) of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 (“HPCA Act”), the Osteopathic Council of New Zealand makes the following notice.

Notice

1. Title and Commencement

(1) This notice may be cited as the Osteopathic Council (Fees) Notice 2023.

(2) This notice comes into force on **1 April 2023**.

(3) The Osteopathic Council (Fees) Notice 2022, published in the [New Zealand Gazette, 14 February 2022, Notice No. 2022-gs649](#), is revoked.

2. Fees

(1) The fees set out in the Schedule are payable for the matters to which they relate.

(2) The fees payable under this notice are payable to the Osteopathic Council of New Zealand (“council”). All fees charged by the council are non-refundable.
